Step 4: "Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves."

#### Member Share - Step 4, Brian L.

A lot of people say we should not talk about Step 4 as something scary or hard, because a newcomer might be afraid to take this important step. But from my experience, I needed to learn that sometimes the hard way is worth it. Like many others, I experimented with different ways to deal with my "drinking problem": from trying to control my drinking to reading all sorts of self-help books. I sought all the easy ways and half measures. I first attended AA 8 years before I finally got sober in 2021. If someone had told me that there is an easy way to do Step 4, I would have attempted it and as soon as I struggled, I would have abandoned it.

I had to become desperate enough to be willing. In February of 2021, the pain finally became so unbearable that I found myself in AA again, speaking to an old timer. For some reason, this time was different. All I can remember from that conversation after the Monday Night Big Book Study was one word ... willingness, and I decided that this time I would be willing.

Was I scared to do Step 4? Yes. Who wants to write down all their resentments, fears, and harms done to others? Was it hard for me to do the work of Step 4? Yes. I didn't want to take an honest look at myself. So why did I do a 4th step inventory then? I did it because of all the people who came before me and told me that although it is difficult, it will keep me sober and be a building block for a life of happiness, joy and freedom.

I was willing to listen to others and do the hard work. I had learned from working Steps 1-3 that my feelings are important, but sometimes it doesn't matter how I feel; what matters is what I do. Working Step 4 taught me so much about myself and showed me the truth of who I was. It allowed me to work the rest of the steps and to practice this program in my life. Working this step is part of the reason that I have a life that is so much better than I could have imagined when I first came to AA. When I got here, I just wanted the pain and suffering to end, but if I had gotten that, I would have sold myself short of so much life had to offer.

One important piece of advice I heard early in my sobriety was that I do not need to be ready for all the steps right now, I just need to work on the step that is in front of me and trust I will be ready for each step as I get to it. My experience taught me that Step 4 is a little scary and a little hard, but it is worth it.




