I want to share some thoughts about how I prepared the 2021 budget.

When I took on the treasurer position in February 2020, I basically walked into a bank balance with no past records. I worked hard with the information I did have and compared it to bank statements to start anew and be able to have records from here on out for our district to look back on.

With that being said, preparing a budget without looking at past years numbers plus knowing we have encountered an extremely rare year, I took into consideration that:

- 1. This is ONLY a budget. If some of the budgets were significantly lowered or raised it is due to looking at where money is being spent to help the still suffering alcoholic. Remember, if the committee needs more than is budgeted, the only difference is that a request is submitted to the district. On the other hand, if the committee doesn't need all the money or sees that the district does not have their approved money; it will not be able to be used.
- 2. We are in a pandemic. Everything from contributions to which committees are spending their typical budget is completely different than it ever has been. I would venture to say that 2021 would look very similar to 2020 in the ways that we are doing business.

I have attached the 2021 proposal as well as the 2020's budget and actual spending.
