We also finished the Treatment Committee workbook. Lots of ideas were gathered to hopefully implement in the future!

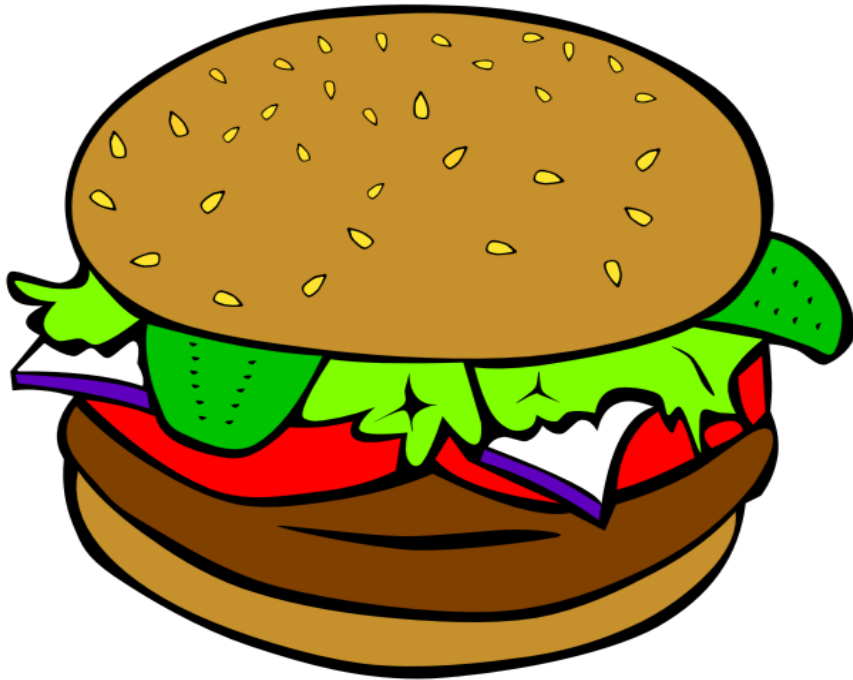

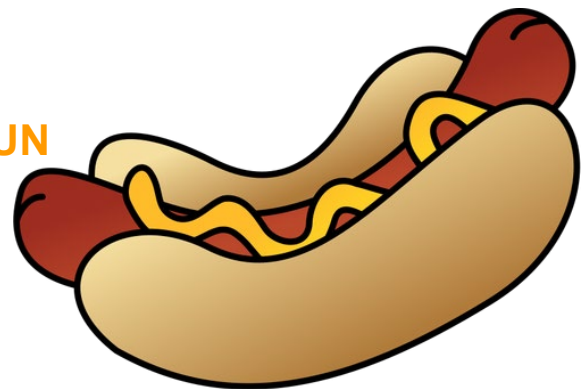

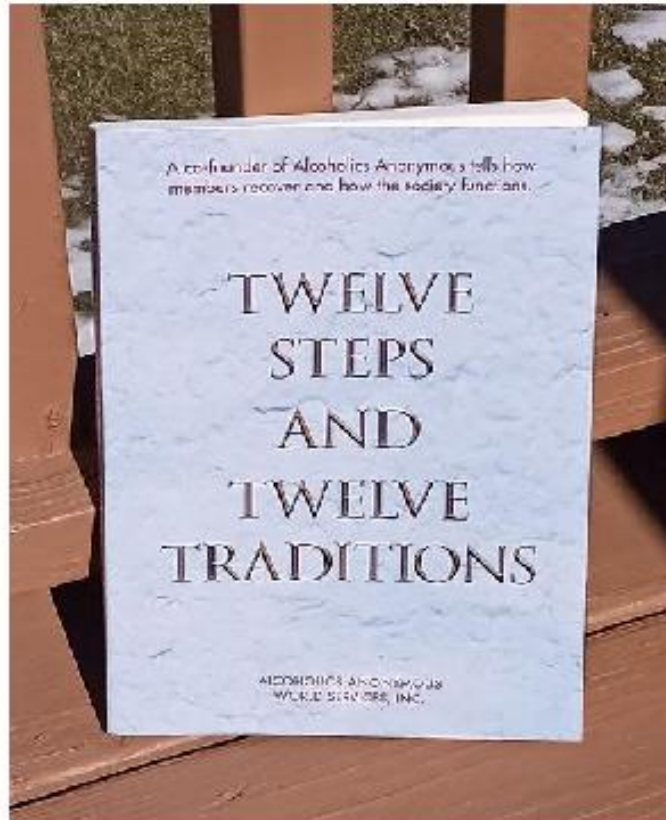
